## WHY SPECIALTY CERTIFICATION?



EXAMINATIONS are not meant to test entry-level knowledge, but rather to TEST the experienced paramedics' SKILLS and KNOWLEDGE.

The Certified Community Paramedic (CP-C) credential targets competency at the MASTERY LEVEL OF PARAMEDIC PRACTICE coupled with entry-level competency over the knowledge, skills and abilities contained within the Community Paramedic specialty.



## CREDENTIALING

- The process of VALIDATING KNOWLEDGE and skills of a medical provider.
- CREDENTIALING is increasingly important because it is the one procedure that ALLOWS PATIENTS to confidently place their TRUST in their healthcare providers.
- Follows a STANDARDIZED PROCESS involving data collection, primary source verification and committee review.
- HOSPITALS, REGULATORS, PEERS and PATIENTS are assured of their healthcare professional's MERIT and EXPERIENCE.



## **PRACTICE GUIDELINES**

- There is NOT a prescribed education program tied to any examination.

Examinations measure a UNIQUE DOMAIN beyond entry-level certification or licensure.
