

#### Modified C3FIT Study by Dr. Gaines

 Healthcare Team follows patients from stroke admission in ED for 12 months post discharge

 Care teams perform home visits to modify risk factors and assess recovery


- Decrease readmissions

- Adults living in Albuquerque
- Discharge to home
- English, Spanish, or Vietnamese speaking

Consent

#### Visitation Schedule



- Mon-Fri 0800-1530
  - 2 hours per visit
- 24-72 hrs. of discharge
- 30/60/90 days
- 6 month
- 9 month
- One year

# Coordination of Care

- Follow up appointments
- Medications access/adherence
- Home health presence
- Physical Therapy
- Uber rides
- Home modifications
- Food/Utility/Rental Assistance



#### Assessment Tools

- Stroke Impact Scale
- NIH Stroke Scale
- Vital Signs
- Morisky Medication Adherence Scale
- PHQ-9 Depression Screening
- Modified Caregiver Strain Index
- Fire Risk assessment
- Crisis Response Canine Wrigley





#### Fall Risk Assessment

- Fall prevention education
- Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)
  - Katz index of independence
- Stretches
- Prescribed PT movements



### Home Modifications

Devices installed within 2 weeks of discharge

- Grab bars
- Wheelchair Ramps
- Bed rails
- Toilet seat
- Door Widening










AFR Installed 417 Assist Devices In 2021 and 314 in 2022

Readmission!!


244 Referred / 78 Enrolled

1 graduate with 14 more graduating in the next month!

90% of patients so far need home modifications

#### **Results:**

- NIHSS improvement
- Stroke Impact Scale improves average of 91.6 points
- Biggest impact on medication access and adherence
- Significant improvement in PHQ-9 depression score (mod to minimal)




# Stroke Survivors Stories

- Establishing trust for those struggling with addiction
- Confirming medications for patients
- Preventing injuries through home modifications
- Helping patients navigate healthcare
- Assisting patients with getting medications
- Providing assistive devices to those in need

#### **Next Steps**

- Address caregiver strain
- Meet patient at rehab prior to discharge home
- Explore Reimbursement by insurance
- Spread the program to other departments in the state
